SUMMARY OF RESULTS: QUICK SURVEY - STATUS OF YOUR OUT OF SCHOOL CARE DURING COVID-19 SITUATION

Please find below a summary of results from the recent quick survey we conducted regards the current status of OSC services.

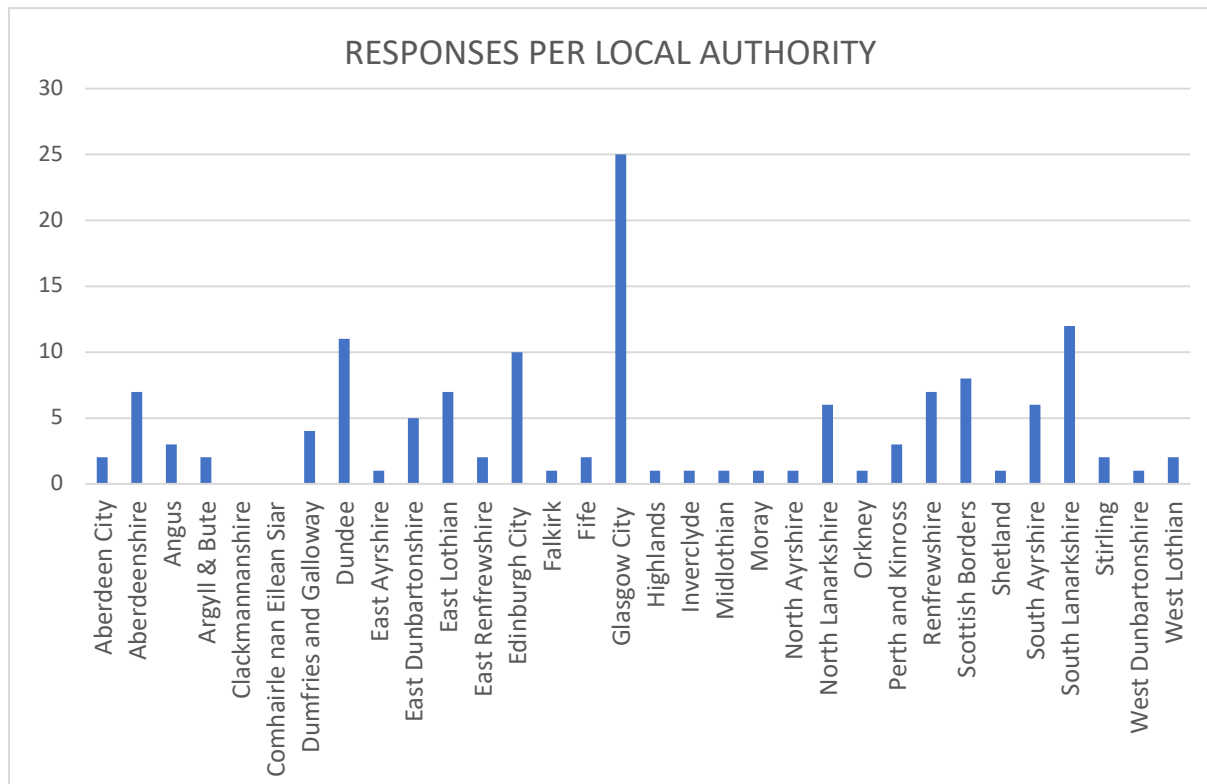
We have also conducted conversations with some Local Authorities (LA). The initial approach taken by LAs has varied across Scotland – some have included OSC services either to provide supplementary support to hubs or directly provide places on behalf of the LA. Some services are not included in LA plans but are able to stay open because they have their own premises and have sufficient demand from key worker families already using the service.

Through conversations with some LAs, even if services have not initially been included in plans, this might change as demands change over the course of the current situation- this might mean engaging with services either for staff or to reopen a service. Also, take-up of places for essential workers has also not been as initially as high as perhaps expected in some areas, so there is currently limited need, however this is a situation which may change and develop through time.

We appreciate that some services are keen to open however, the health and safety of staff should be your priority. We would also point services to the various business support schemes that have been put in place both by UK and Scottish governments. See <https://soscn.org> for further info.

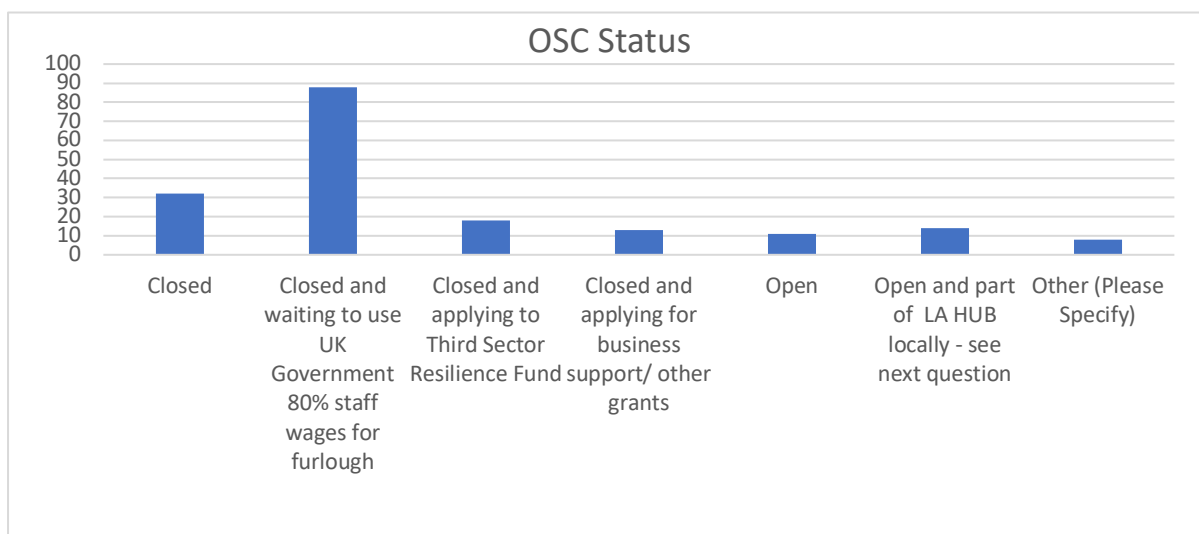
