Out of School Childcare is more affordable than you might think

I wish I could afford school age childcare

If you are working and receive Universal Credit you might be able to get help totalling up to 85% to pay for childcare costs.

So, for example, if the after school childcare fees are £12 per session- you could receive up to £10.20 from the government and then you only need to contribute the additional £1.80.

Did you know you might be able to get government help to pay for out of school care?



Support to pay for childcare through Universal Credit and the Tax-free Childcare System can be used for all registered childcare (out of school childcare, nursery & childminders) If you are working and not eligible for universal credit due to higher earnings, you can still access support to cover 20% of childcare costs through the Tax-free Childcare System.

So, for example, if the after school childcare fees are £12 per session- you could receive up to £2.40 from the government and then you only pay the additional £9.60.
